Microsoft recommends activating MFA, and there is no additional license charge from Microsoft to enable this feature on your account. O365 MFA Service Features

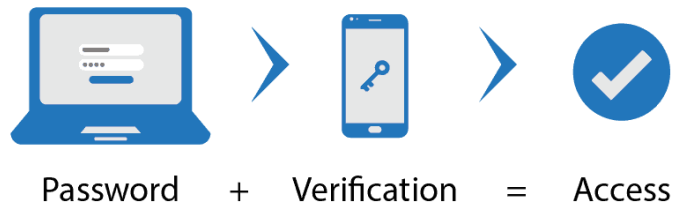
- Enable and enforce MFA for selected users.
- Allow a one-time password to mobile phones or apps as a second authentication method.
- Allow phone calls as a second authentication factor.
- Allow verification through an SMS message.
- Enforce application passwords for non-browser clients like Outlook.
- Use the default Microsoft welcome greetings for authenticating phone calls.
